AUTONOMY, EQUITY, BELONGING

The Equipe Autonomiste party, as its name suggests, advocates for autonomy. Our vision for society entails Quebec's autonomy within Canada and the empowerment of individuals.

What is autonomy? Autonomy is:

- A political right aimed at individual self-governance, that is, a policy of freedom within the limits of rights comparable to those of others. In other words, it is responsible freedom.
- The power/capacity to act by one's own means. In this sense, autonomy is the true form of independence, both for individuals and for the independence of the Quebec state.

To ensure maximum individual freedom, we uphold the principle of subsidiarity, which essentially states: let the lowest level of government capable of making a decision do so. This principle allows for the greatest possible freedom without anarchy. It implies:

- Decentralization of the state.
- A better form of democracy by facilitating the expression of community needs and enabling better political practices.

On our platform, we propose solutions that align with these values. We know that local stakeholders understand the issues better than any politician and possess potential solutions. We are an active citizens' party.

In this spirit, based on the principle of subsidiarity, we want to demand that the Quebec government exercise **all the powers it is capable of while maintaining our place in the confederation, provided our provincial autonomy is recognized.**

In this way, we will achieve a true Canadian confederation where all members are equal and no longer subject to federal centralization and interference in our own backyard. In this document, Equipe Autonomiste will also take a stand on areas of jurisdiction that the federal government has unilaterally appropriated.

The Equipe Autonomiste party fully recognizes that this is an ideal that must aim both to grant greater freedom and to ensure that the most vulnerable are considered and given the necessary means to exercise their right to freedom.

This is why we say we are the only party promoting responsible freedom, meaning that we are also the party of fairness.

With this in mind, we also advocate for **responsible immigration** limited by the degree of integration possible, so that immigrants can participate in Quebec's collective life without losing the unique character of our culture. We strive to be unifying forces. Faced with the evident destruction of the social fabric, we believe it is essential to rediscover a sense of belonging.

Autonomy (or responsible freedom)

1. Individual Autonomy

- a. Return power and money to the people while regulating this freedom;
- b. Promote the user-pay principle;
- c. Privatize or encourage the private sector in all areas of responsibility other than legislation, the administration of justice, primary and secondary education, emergency and life-sustaining services, and infrastructure;
- d. Repeal the excessive number of laws that restrict the freedom of Quebec citizens.

2. State Autonomy

- a. Reinstate Quebec's autonomy within Canada in the Constitution: Quebec independence is not our struggle;
- b. Repatriate and renegotiate our constitutional powers;
- c. Reduce the size of the state; this will allow for more effective monitoring of corruption, incompetence, or inefficiency. This solution will not only lead to a more efficient state, but will also reduce the debt, which is generational theft, as well as lower taxes.
 - i. Establish a committee responsible for repealing and simplifying existing laws;
- d. Decentralize power in accordance with the principle of subsidiarity;
- e. Free ourselves from interference in our decision-making autonomy, such as that caused by the UN or the WHO.

Equity

Equity is not about giving everyone the same thing, but about ensuring the same law for everyone. The only acceptable differences in the law between individuals should be their contribution to society and their means of freely providing for their own subsistence.

1. Restore the true fundamental principles of social justice

- a. For us, social justice is defined as follows: “that every citizen contributes to the advancement of society to the best of their ability, and that society only cares for those who truly need it”

b. Abolish all laws and programs based on discrimination (so-called affirmative action, which goes by various ideological names such as “parity” or “inclusion”);

2. Defend intergenerational equity

- a. Do not leave debt to the next generation by cutting the inefficient public service network;
- b. Provide the necessary support for children’s full development;
- c. Protect the elderly;

3. Defend True Equity Between Men and Women:

We believe that there is still work to be done to advance women's equality; however, men also suffer injustices, particularly in the legal and professional spheres.

Equipe Autonomiste is one of the only political parties in Quebec advocating for men's rights during elections.

- a. Continue to defend women's rights;
- b. Address issues specific to women:
 - i. Regulate the right to and funding of late-term abortion.
 - ii. Legalize and regulate prostitution;
 - iii. Prevent femicides by studying, identifying, and addressing the causes; for example, by implementing measures to de-escalate marital tensions;
- c. Defend Men's Rights:
 - i. Create a Ministry for Men's Rights;
 - ii. Launch a public inquiry into domestic violence against men;
 - iii. We will punish false accusations more severely;
 - iv. We will correct the flaws in the child support system;
 - v. We will establish a presumption of shared custody in separations rather than sole custody being too easily granted to women;
 - vi. We will launch public awareness campaigns to encourage both men and women to report the violence they experience, whether physical or psychological;
 - vii. We will encourage boys to study by valuing them for who they are and adapting their education to their needs;
 - viii. We will prepare boys and girls for citizenship and parenthood by establishing a course in home economics and civic life.

Belongning

1. Respect and promote the customs, values, and laws of Quebec;
 - a. Defend secularism both in the state and in the public sphere, while respecting our Catholic cultural and historical heritage;
 - b. Protect and enhance our heritage;
 - c. More severely condemn public vandalism of cultural heritage, considering it anti-democratic;
 - d. Demand that the federal government respect the principle of the two founding peoples of the Confederation;
2. Prioritize local families;
3. Ensure the successful integration of new immigrants, as well as the successful integration of immigrants already present;
 - a. To this end, reduce the immigration threshold to an acceptable level that allows for responsible integration and enables them to contribute as effectively and quickly as possible to Quebec society;
 - b. Demand that Ottawa exercise control over our own immigration; We support the idea of a natural right, the right to ensure the continuation of one's existence.
 - c. Select immigrants based on their professional qualifications, as well as their values;
 - d. Facilitate the recognition of professional skills;
4. Optimize social cohesion;
 - a. Improve democratic governance so that every part of our society can express itself freely;
 - b. Revalue freedom of expression;
 - c. Improve citizen consultation;
 - d. Ensure fairness in all laws;
 - e. Regulate ideological movements in universities.

FAMILY AND IMMIGRATION: AN INCLUSIVE NATIONALISM



Equipe Autonomiste party aims to recreate a sense of belonging: a new project in partnership with immigrants who wish to participate. Equipe Autonomiste also seeks to **preserve Quebec's values and customs.**

The best way to transmit values and preserve our unique culture is based first and foremost on the traditional family model, as this model has proven its worth throughout history.

The role of the State is fundamentally to adequately represent the general will of those who grew up with these inherited values and traditions, to represent those who have dedicated their lives to preserving the culture.

A culture is not just a language, but real men, women, and children who use a language to express who they are. **To preserve our culture, we must first support those who have kept it alive and continue to do so.**

We therefore believe that we must first encourage our families, since they represent a core set of values (a moral compass); the family also plays a crucial role in education. We have a problem with a declining birth rate. Equipe Autonomiste is the only party tackling this problem.

On the other hand, immigration in Quebec has become a reality. **Many immigrants have contributed, continue to contribute, and will continue to contribute to Quebec's development.**

However, let's be clear: integration problems, which Quebec ignored barely 10 years ago, are now the subject of every casual conversation, despite the establishment's deafening silence. There is a pervasive unease within the population that demands action.

Equipe Autonomiste first wishes to tell immigrants that we have a moral duty to respect all human life and that we consider you to be full-fledged Quebecers.

Except that we must tell the truth:

- We must acknowledge the grievances and distinctiveness of the French-Canadian people, who are disappearing in what we might call a “**quiet genocide**,” perpetrated by the English-speaking federal government and the silence of a political correctness that is unrepresentative of the original founding people.
- We must denounce the systematic use of immigration by several political parties in the pay of international big business to drive down wages. In other words, immigrants are being exploited to become the new “cheap labor” of the state and big business.
- We must admit our current inability to properly integrate immigrants.
- Our population is aging, and we urgently need to readjust the age pyramid.

With regard to immigration, we must therefore plan for responsible and sustainable immigration in the long term; to economic immigration, we must oppose the veto of humanity and make ourselves respected by the federal government in the **preservation of the founding people**.

Family

1. Restore autonomy to families;
 - a. Reaffirm parental primacy;
 - b. Improve the oversight of the Youth Protection Services (DPJ);
2. Defend gender equality;
 - a. Defend women's rights;
 - i. Prevention of femicides;
 - b. Defend men's rights;
 - i. Presumption of shared custody;
 - ii. Work towards genuine equality in family law;
 - iii. Increase the number of support centers for men;
 - iv. Impose sentences at least equal to those for false accusations;
 - c. Defend the rights of transgender people alongside those of children;
 - i. Protect the right to safety and respect for transgender people;
 - ii. Prohibit the indoctrination of children with gender theory and early gender transitions;

3. Encourage Quebecers to increase their birth rate;
 - a. Greater recognition of the role of stay-at-home parents;
 - b. Direct the currently subsidized amount for childcare centres (CPEs) to parents who wish to stay home to care for their children; this amount would be tax-free and in the child's name;
 - c. Improve incentives and conditions to offer greater work-life balance in the workplace;
 - i. For example, encourage companies with 500 or more employees to provide on-site childcare;
 - ii. Similarly, establish on-site childcare for government employees, such as nurses;

Emigration

1. To prevent brain exode, for professions requiring university qualifications, the true cost of education should be charged; universities could remain subsidized; an annual deduction of 10% of gross income earned over 10 years of work in Quebec would be offered. Equipe Autonomiste would also offer the possibility of a full refund to those who wish to emigrate within 10 years.
2. For any socio-economic or socio-professional benefits offered, companies should be required to reimburse the benefits provided (as in Switzerland); an annual deduction of -10% would be applied.

Childhood

1. Require Ottawa to prohibit late-term abortion, except under certain conditions such as medical conditions or post-traumatic events.
2. Facilitate the processes of adoption by relatives and the relinquishment of parental rights (accelerated termination of parental rights in certain serious cases).
3. Demand increased legal measures or penalties for child abuse (physical violence);
 - a. Regarding sexual violence against children and pedophilia, the Autonomist Team would study all available means to ensure the lifelong safety of children. For example:
 - i. Facilitate monitoring and reporting by all stakeholders in the health sector, political figures, or first responders;
 - ii. Analyze the possibility of implementing lifelong tracking bracelets;
 - iii. Introduce chemical castration for repeat offenders or the death penalty;

Seniors

There is a hidden wealth within our seniors that we are "stored in undignified conditions."

Those who have worked all their lives should not lack for necessities and should be able to end their days with dignity.

1. Allocate funds or credits for intergenerational housing;
2. Integrate seniors into civic, intellectual (professional), and professional life by mentoring young people;
3. Severely punish violence against seniors. Monitor these places as if they were institutional settings.
4. Study and implement models that have abolished long-term care facilities and improved home-based care.

Immigration

1. Ensure the successful integration of immigrants, as well as the successful integration of existing immigrants;
 - a. To this end, reduce the immigration threshold to an acceptable level to allow for responsible integration and enable them to contribute to Quebec society (between 6 and 7% per generation, during a moratorium that could lead to a long-term policy);
 - b. Demand that Ottawa exercise control over our immigration;
 - c. Select immigrants based on their professional qualifications, values, and religion/ideology;
 - d. Facilitate the recognition of professional skills;
 - e. Require foreign students to pay the true cost of education for their university studies;
 - f. Support the recommendation against wearing religious symbols in situations of authority;
2. Suspension of citizenship rights
 - a. for certain violent or serious crimes;
 - b. for prolonged unwillingness to work;
3. Grant citizenship based on four out of five conditions;
 - a. Reside in the territory (land);

- b. Be born to parents who have been Quebec citizens for at least 5 years;
- c. Work and moral character
 - i. Favor immigration from Christian or Western countries;
 - ii. Repatriate our constitutional powers over immigration;
 - iii. Require the federal government to provide criminal records for offenses committed outside Quebec;
 - iv. Language;
 - v. Needs of the host country;
- 4. Temporary visa for 5 years and citizenship for 10 years;

Reasonable Accommodation

- 1. Reiterate the principle that “laws must be the same for everyone”; therefore, “wokism” and D.E.I. (diversity, equity, and inclusion) must be denounced, as they are in reality forms of racial or sexual discrimination, since a “race” or a sex possesses privileges on this basis.
- 2. Laws must not be arbitrary; they must be rational and based on the principle of respect for individual rights.

Indian Affairs

- 1. End discrimination based on race.
- 2. Demand that the federal government:
 - a. Abolish the reserve system;
 - b. Abolish the Indian Affairs Act.
- 3. Recognize First Nations, like Quebec, as a founding people, but without the possibility of separation from the country.

SOCIAL ECONOMY: THE ONLY EQUITABLE SOCIAL PROGRAM IS ACCESS TO EMPLOYMENT



Equipe Autonomiste party considers it an inviolable principle that the State has a duty to maintain the necessities required for the subsistence of citizens who fully participate in social life or wish to participate in it.

It is a principle of human dignity, as a nation, to ensure such solidarity in the face of the unjust suffering of others. It is therefore our duty to protect the lives of the most vulnerable social classes, that is, those who lack the means to ensure their own survival (such as children and the elderly).

Poverty is a social ill, especially when it is suffered by families or workers who contribute to the well-being of society as a whole. Thus, a responsible State must address the real causes of poverty instead of funding unemployment.

A responsible State also has a duty to create the conditions necessary for prosperity. However, the wealth of a nation depends first and foremost on the organization of labor and investment opportunities.

It is therefore necessary to allow the full participation of all in collective life so that they are able to decently satisfy their needs and create a social environment conducive to the desire to work.

Everyone must be able to develop the new skills necessary to reach their full potential at work. Those who work honestly must be able to provide for themselves honestly.

For all these reasons, we oppose funding idleness, since it penalizes workers by rewarding inaction. Furthermore, it is unfair for the government to exploit honest workers to fund poverty that benefits the political class. Let's end the policy of perpetuating subsidized poverty.

Equipe Autonomiste party does not want to provide subsidies that only alleviate individual poverty at the expense of collective wealth.

As for most community organizations, we believe they fulfill essential functions for the well-being of the most vulnerable, provided they receive public funding.

Many perform social functions that cannot be delegated to private enterprise. For example: assistance with alcoholism, drug addiction, victims of assault, homelessness, or mental health support.

We believe it is self-evident that in order to share wealth, it must first be created by promoting free enterprise and the personal benefit of working.

Preventing someone from working and providing for their needs is contrary to the protection of individuals. Penalizing workers with heavy taxes and levies is contrary to common sense.

For us, the only viable and responsible political program is to enable as much access to work as possible for everyone.

Clean up the financing of poverty.

1. Review the social assistance system;
 - a. Provide more support to those unable to work;
 - b. Provide more support to low-income families;
 - c. Help train those receiving assistance so they can fill in-demand jobs;
 - d. Subsidize the wages of underqualified individuals to integrate them into the workforce, allowing them to develop and learn skills directly needed in the workplace;
 - e. Penalize able-bodied individuals who abuse social assistance;
 - f. Limit immigration based on labor and skills needs;
2. Implement a flat tax rate:
 - a. Simplify government operations and reduce the size of the government;
 - b. Automate taxes to decrease the number of civil servants;
 - c. In the long term, aim to minimize taxes on wages;
3. Ensure that money goes primarily to those who have earned it;

4. Establish procedures for continuous improvement and monitoring of public funds, in order to "cut the fat"

- a. In particular, we must review state services, in order to privatize what should not be under its jurisdiction.
- b. We must end the culture of subsidizing businesses, as it is contrary to free enterprise, preferential, conducive to corruption, and destructive to competition and performance; moreover, subsidies imply higher taxes. This culture creates a dependency on the public funds market. Businesses should not be kept alive by the state.
- c. We must end purchase subsidies, since they increase the purchase price and impact the ability to compete in other markets;
- d. Establish state oversight bodies;
- e. Simplify state processes;
- f. Eliminate artificial constraints on labor, such as rights, permits, trades, and inter-provincial regulations;
- g. Review the public service union model;
- h. Review the uniform public service salary structure;
- i. Promote necessary local government procurement;
- j. Decentralization of structures, in order to allow more flexibility to actors in the field;

Working in collaboration with community organizations

1. Review the funding of community organizations to ensure that funds are used effectively, meaning that they truly benefit those who need them;
2. Recognize community action and the role it plays in the community by improving cooperation with community stakeholders; this will lead to a better understanding of the population's needs and the development of fairer policies;
3. Provide an online platform for the community economy;

Social Housing

1. Deregulate constraints on developers;
2. Improve lease transfer conditions for both landlords and tenants;
3. Reform the Administrative Housing Court (TAL);
4. Demand stricter maintenance of the housing stock;
5. Abolish the welcome tax (Bienvenue's tax).

Encouraging Prosperity and National Wealth

1. Encourage the production of luxury goods;
2. Restrict and amend free trade to control the flow of capital;
3. Provide a new "deal" in the civil service: in exchange for higher wages, union members would accept more flexible job descriptions;

Promoting a Culture of Work and Competition

1. To improve technical skills in the market, replace unemployment and social assistance with technical training;
2. State payment for certain prostheses or provision of suitable employment opportunities for people with disabilities.
3. Develop a full-employment policy;
4. Eliminate certain exclusive rights held by specific professions to ensure fair competition.
5. Maintain the freedom of professionals with a professional order to express their opinions in public debate, independently of their professional order.
6. Limit intellectual property rights to support small and medium businesses.

The Power of Cooperation and the Common Good

1. Legal prohibition of lobbying by making information public (transparency);
2. Considering that land ownership is a common good, provided there is a willingness to defend it, a return on investment through property taxes (land cannot be a commodity);
3. Making tools for sale and export publicly available.

EDUCATION AND CULTURE: PARTNERS OF THE ECONOMY



The Equipe Autonomiste party believes that education is not limited to school. Indeed, our vision of education is much broader than that. We distinguish between education and instruction.

- Education encompasses all activities that shape the character of individuals. Examples include the military, cadets, the workplace, and family, in addition to school.
- Instruction is the transmission of knowledge; this depends on networks for the distribution and circulation of knowledge. Examples include the media, art, and the workplace, in addition to school.

The primary goal of education must be the formation of citizens; that is, the formation of citizens capable of playing a practical role in society (profession), possessing the moral qualities to do so, and aware of its history and guiding principles.

This primarily involves educating children in civic responsibility, that is, in the knowledge of the rights and duties of the individual within their community. The goal of education and instruction for children must be to transform them into autonomous and responsible adults.

The State has a duty to provide a suitable and decent learning environment. When the State extends sex education beyond scientific facts, as is the case with gender ideology, or when universities "teach" an ideology like Wokism, then this is not instruction, but a form of "moral" education; the school then becomes a tool of propaganda.

For adolescents and adults, it is essential to be able to be citizens participating in political life through the development of intellectual work skills, including critical thinking based on adequate general knowledge that allows us to preserve our cultural heritage and values.

Knowledge must be evaluated according to its relevance. The quality of education lies in the *practical* development of skills to achieve a goal or objective in independent or professional life. For example, a good doctor is judged by their results. Consequently, it is

through skills that we can judge good and bad education, and that we can teach the most effective models.

We must assess the actual skills required to participate in social life by knowing how to read, write, and do arithmetic correctly.

We must also assess the professional skills of training networks. To do this, the professional sector must play a greater role in demanding the skills to be taught and enabling the recognition and transmission of knowledge close to and within the concrete environments of work.

Artists protest publicly when the government cuts subsidized arts funding, as if the state were betraying a fundamental right. This often results in a haughty form of culture that interests no one because, they believe, it is not understood. We believe that this kind of culture must first and foremost be popular and appeal to the masses. Culture, such as cinema or art, is part of popular education when it transmits certain values, whether by glorifying, denouncing, or challenging them. Art can express and reflect who we are.

Culture is also a form of education when it serves as a vehicle for knowledge; for example, cinema can be used to showcase our history. When "culture" caters only to a select few, it becomes compartmentalized. It is no longer a culture that expresses itself and reflects who we are. It is only through its social dimension that art should be able to receive public funding. The prerequisite for this representation is freedom of expression.

Promoting our culture and values

1. End mandatory attendance at ethics and religious culture courses in public schools and allow a course on Quebec culture and values;
2. Involve young people in school tasks to increase their autonomy and raise their awareness of community needs;
3. Moral Education
 - a. Prevent the indoctrination of gender theories in schools;
4. Provide support for dropouts;
5. Allow and support classroom discipline;
6. Reinstate physical education classes;
7. Promote excellence;
8. Provide benefits and tax support for homeschooling.

Promoting education that fosters a strong economy

1. Provide civic, democratic, and economic education;
2. Due to illiteracy, it is urgent to reform education in Quebec through a series of measures described on our website;
3. Recognize foreign diplomas more quickly;
4. Recognize and facilitate on-the-job training;
 - a. Register on-the-job training programs;
 - b. Provide businesses with access to teaching materials;
 - c. Promote on-the-job training;
 - d. Enhance the value of vocational and technical courses;
 - e. Recognize credits for work experience acquired by children aged 14 and over;
 - i. Repeal the ban on youth employment;
 - f. Make training facilities available for rent with a participation credit for on-the-job training;
5. Establish a permanent program to provide literacy training for school dropouts; The inability to read and do arithmetic is a barrier to performing professional tasks and participating in democratic life, which requires the ability to access information and express oneself;
6. Course notes and school materials are the property of the employer (they must be made publicly available for use by other teachers in the Quebec school system).
7. Maintain both private and public schools, considering that even with partial funding, private schools allow for savings on education.
8. Promote English from the first year of elementary school to encourage commerce;
9. Ensure the quality of education and its responsiveness to economic needs through a commission that would facilitate collaboration between the government, education, and employers;
10. Prevent brain drain by ensuring that those who leave pay a fair price (requirement to work for a certain period in Quebec to avoid educational costs).

Promoting Research

1. Promote scientific training;
2. Promote structures that bridge the gap between academic research and industry;
3. Reassess the allocation of research and development funds;

Funding Higher Education

1. Liberalize tuition fees;
2. Redefine the mandate of school boards and adjust their size accordingly;
3. Re-evaluate the usefulness of the CEGEP model (common core curriculum);
4. Eliminate funding for universities that indoctrinate instead of teaching;

Let's consider three scenarios for financing higher education.

1. Either the employer is the government, in which case the state should pay for the training of its civil servants in the form of an interest-free loan.
2. Or it is within the framework of a profession, in which case it is legitimate for the state to request financial participation from businesses, since they benefit from the training of qualified employees. The state should limit the number of places based on the job market and adapt the training to the specific development of professional skills in the market.

These skills should be defined in collaboration with stakeholders in the field. In some cases, this allows for the transfer of knowledge directly within companies by recognizing them or enabling high-performing companies to share their expertise.

In the case of unemployment due to changes in professional qualifications, it is better for the state to finance studies that allow students to update their skills.

3. Or the student is taking courses for personal interest, in which case the costs should be borne by the individual.

Quebec must be French

1. Oppose so-called "inclusive" writing
2. Choose French immigration whose culture is close to ours;
3. The public service and education in Quebec must be in French as the sole official language of Quebec;

ENERGY: PREVENTING CATASTROPHE

Energy is the foundation of industrial production power. Considering that:

- Oil is more efficient than alternative energy sources,
- Oil is theoretically a finite resource, and these quantities are difficult to estimate for several reasons,
- The high demand for energy, as well as our dependence on this resource

We conclude that we are heading towards a serious energy (oil) crisis, for which alternative energy sources are not ready and may not even be sufficient.

Energy is the basis of transportation, heating, the maintenance of critical infrastructure, and food production. Consequently, a nation's ability to move, heat, stay safe, and feed itself is directly linked to the control and management of its energy resources.

We are not opposed to the use of oil, but we propose **responsible management of collective energy resources**.

Energy sovereignty

1. Aim for energy independence to the greatest extent possible;
 - a. Develop our hydrocarbon resources;
 - b. Study, refine, and consider nuclear energy as an alternative to oil; use thermal waste from power plants for cogeneration where possible (supply heat to nearby urban areas).
 - c. Study, refine, and improve the efficiency of solar energy as an alternative to oil;
 - d. Denounce and curb wind power development, which harms our agricultural and tourism potential, since this technology is actually inefficient and polluting;
 - e. Develop the secondary and tertiary processing of aluminum;
2. Revitalize Hydro-Québec International (sell electricity at a higher price than locally);
3. Denounce the political and economic exploitation of eco-anxiety.
 - a. Withdraw from the Kyoto Protocol;
 - b. Repeal all laws on the monopoly of electric vehicles;
 - c. Repeal and make public agreements made under the pretext of environmental protection with supranational organizations such as the UN and the World Economic Forum;

Energy Management

1. Establish responsible management of the State's energy needs
 - a. Manage the lighting of buildings, public spaces, and streets. These represent approximately 5% to 15% of total consumption in Quebec.
2. Establish comprehensive management of energy resources
 - a. Tax Bitcoin production due to its extremely energy-intensive nature;
 - b. Focus the management of data centers.
 - c. Manage the supply of non-renewable energy;
 - d. Combat obsolescence, notably by distributing the costs of waste disposal;
 - e. Maintain or increase oil prices to reduce demand and invest in research into alternatives or the installation of nuclear power plants;
 - f. Leave energy management and production under lease;
3. Moratorium on Hydro-Québec and review of its mandate to forecast energy demand, the sustainability, and the reliability of the grid;
4. Sell energy at the true price and thus put an end to the preferential energy prices enjoyed by certain companies; the Autonomist Team considers this a form of disguised subsidies.

Transition to Green Energy

1. Allow the market to manage oil independently;
2. Maintain a ratio between vegetation cover and the number of cars;
3. Combat road traffic—as a wasteful energy expenditure—through a national urban planning strategy;
4. Better fund research in "green" energies (solar, nuclear, oil substitutes and replicas, natural gas);
 - a. Enable genuine energy competition so that the market is less energy-intensive;
 - b. Stop funding hydrogen as a scientific scam;
 - c. Expose the green illusion;
5. Promote geothermal energy in large government and public buildings;
6. Offer credits, reduced rates, or other forms of incentives to renovate homes and other buildings to improve their energy efficiency (insulation, consumption, lighting control, heat exchange, etc.)

GOVERNANCE: THE ORDER NECESSARY FOR FREEDOM



Governance is the relationship the state maintains with its citizens to regulate their interactions. The state is the social organization that must serve the citizen.

The Equipe Autonomiste party prioritizes the freest possible government. To achieve this, individuals must also be as free as possible. Consequently, the state must be minimal and only intervene in the relationships between individuals when such intervention is necessary to avoid the use of force or to prevent leaving a vulnerable person in need. It must be based on the principle of subsidiarity, meaning it is decentralized. A true democracy must be accountable and transparent.

For the sake of fairness, justice must be accessible to all; otherwise, it is not justice at all. We also believe that charity towards the criminal is a betrayal of the victim. The criminal must receive a punishment proportionate to the malicious act, and the victim must be supported.

A true democracy: representative, accountable, and transparent

1. Establish a representative democracy

- a. Reaffirm the freedom of expression necessary for public debate;
 - i. Abolish the notion of hate speech while maintaining the criminalization of threats and defamation in law; citizens always have the right, and even the duty, to criticize their government, and citizen criticism should never be considered hate speech. Due to its arbitrary nature, the Equipe Autonomiste party wants to abolish the concept legally.
 - ii. Formally criminalize doxxing;
 - iii. Declare non-democratic organizations such as the far right, the far left, communist parties, and "antifa" as terrorists;
- b. Bring the State closer to the citizen;
 - i. Decentralize power (principle of subsidiarity);

- c. Establish true equity (the same laws for all) by combating so-called "positive" discrimination principles such as gender parity;
- d. Review party financing and representation to allow for genuine representation of smaller parties, which are better suited to representing the population; currently, real political and media representation of alternative or local parties simply does not exist;
- e. Avoid democratic biases by the ruling party that favor them;
- f. Prohibit the publication of opinion polls during the final week of the campaign;
- g. Provide the platform of all political parties to every household during the election.
- h. Limit the display of election advertising to specific locations to ensure equality and order across the territory, thereby reducing environmental and visual pollution.

2. Establish an **Accountable Democracy**

- a. Abolish by-elections;
 - i. Efficiency, cost, and time saved.
 - ii. Respect for the votes of the last general election.
- b. Give the Auditor General the power, following an investigation, to mandate a commission of inquiry; the results of the inquiry must be made public.
- c. Stop paying severance pay to resigning Members of Parliament. The collective benefits package remains intact for the MP given their work.
- d. Prevent laws that exonerate those in power; reinstate accountability and reporting.
- e. Establish a long-term public management committee;
 - i. To establish objectives with a timeframe that extends beyond a single mandate;
 - ii. Prepare emergency plans for the population by identifying possible scenarios (widespread power outages, ice storms, terrorist attacks, etc.).

3. Establish a **transparent democracy.**

- a. Reinstate the Munich Charter regarding journalists and/or impose a professional order on them, as they have a duty of rigor.

4. Reaffirm our **autonomy in Canada and abroad.**

- a. Have our own representation in international institutions such as the UN;
- b. Reserve, through the notwithstanding clause, a right to withdraw from clauses imposed by the UN to preserve our autonomy.
- c. Review our international commitments to maintain our de facto political sovereignty.

Public Safety and Internal Protection

Equipe Autonomiste's plan prioritizes prevention, legitimate surveillance, deterrence, confiscation of the means of crime, and, as a last resort, criminalization. Taxes are only justifiable insofar as emergency services are present to partially ensure the protection of private property and safeguard ownership.

1. Prevention

- a. Mandatory sentences for certain crimes (minimum penalty);

2. Surveillance

- a. The use of force must be filmed, monitored, and documented; the use of force must be proportionate to the opposing force; since the right to use force is not extended to all civilians, it becomes a special case. This measure aims to protect both the police officer and the public.
- b. Increased surveillance of certain public places particularly at risk of crime, for investigative purposes only;

3. Deterrence

- a. War on organized crime through accountability legislation: the possibility of punishment for the crimes of the criminal group.

4. Confiscate the means of crime

- a. Confiscation of organized crime assets to contribute to defense;

5. Adjustment

- a. Combat police corruption and non-enforcement to ensure public trust in the law
- b. The use of state force must be strictly based on the law, and sentences must be proportionate to the crime committed.

6. Penalize

- a. Mandate short processing times for serious crimes against persons;

Access to justice

1. Modernize the justice system to make it less cumbersome and faster;

2. Promote access to justice

- a. Public funding of the victim's defense from the assets of an aggressor in certain cases (the evidence is clear, the harm suffered is real);

- b. Review legislation and procedures to expedite the process;
- c. Prevent collusion between lawyers;
- d. Access to justice for all as a minimum requirement for legitimate governance (percentage of damages);
- e. Increased penalties for proven false statements (sanctions risked by false accusations);

Fair Treatment of Criminals

There are two types of criminals: those who pose a threat to an individual or the community, and those who simply exhibit undesirable behavior. In the first case, the danger to the public must be responsibly considered. In the case of undesirable behavior, rehabilitation is preferable. **The state must manage the manageable risk of rehabilitation.**

1. Punishment minimally proportionate to the harm committed in property crimes
2. Chemical castration for rape and pedophilia, when the evidence is sufficiently strong and the crime was committed with violent aggression (removing the means of perpetration)
3. Reinstatement of the death penalty for very serious crimes against persons (rape with aggression, murder - except in cases of self-defense)
4. Reinstatement of the death penalty (reducing prisoner expenses);
5. The perpetrator must, within the limits of their financial means, at least reimburse the victim's healthcare costs and, in addition, pay compensation for the period of unemployment.
6. Increase penalties for repeat offenders;
7. Maintain current sentencing guidelines, ensuring the prison system's capacity;
8. Ensure equal sentences for the same crime: "equal punishment for equal crime";
9. Increase penalties for political crimes;
10. Reform prisons (as an inefficient luxury and a breeding ground for crime);
11. Decriminalize drug addiction, recognizing it as a rehabilitation need;
12. Implement a reparations program;
13. Make prisons financially self-sufficient and safe for prison guards.

HEALTH: A HUMAN-SIZED INDUSTRY



What we call "health" encompasses all the care provided to alleviate or cure problems of the body or mind (i.e., mental health).

A sick person cannot work and independently support themselves. Illness is a loss of autonomy. There are enormous costs in the healthcare sector, but it is a unique industry because it operates on a human scale.

The consensus is unanimous: the healthcare system is ailing: excessive wait times for care, surgeries delayed by more than a year, limited access to healthcare providers, staff demotivation due to bureaucracy and working conditions, lack of staff retention, and a financial black hole.

Furthermore, nurses are an exploited class in Quebec, since it is virtually impossible for them to strike or change professions due to widespread nationalization.

The « healthcare » system is not working. We must therefore dispel the belief in a universal and free system, while preserving the ethical principle of ensuring that everyone has access to healthcare.

The system has a record budget of \$62 billion in 2025. The true cost is even greater, as these figures do not include the thousands of Quebecers who receive care in other provinces without being reimbursed.

Healthcare is the largest debt sector: it represented 51% of public spending in 2020-2021, with 40% of that allocated to the final year of life. Our current model is simply not sustainable. It is unacceptable that we wait 20 hours for a service that sometimes lasts only 10 minutes. We must get better value for our money. Our system is not free. **It is one of the most expensive for such mediocre performance.**

The Equipe Autonomiste party believes that we must simplify and modernize the administration, improve working conditions, facilitate the delegation of certain tasks, review network funding based on the causes of illness (aggression, pathogens, genetics, foodborne

illness, toxicology, occupational disease, or gerontology), and restore a healthy age pyramid. We must also address the excessive profits from medical equipment.

For the healthcare system to "heal," the unconditional collaboration of the unions will be necessary, as well as a degree of flexibility afforded by a "private" system. The private sector also allows for the retention of employees exasperated by the state monopoly.

The state is a bad employer and a bad manager. We do not want a system where honest workers go into lifelong debt to receive healthcare. For us, this is fundamentally a question of **human dignity**.

From an economic perspective, it is about establishing a service offering that meets fixed healthcare needs. Underfunding and the refusal of the private sector lead to understaffing or longer waiting times for the same service.

Administration

1. Modernize the network
 - a. Computerize medical records;
 - b. Computerize note-taking and prescriptions;
 - c. Standardize hospital management methods;
 - d. Abolish hospital-specific cards in favor of a single card;
 - e. Reduce the number of management staff;
 - f. Reduce unnecessary bureaucracy;
 - g. Facilitate telemedicine
2. Treat locally, i.e., nearby (long-term care facilities)
3. Improve collaboration with hospital administrations;
4. Implement a co-payment system, except for children.
5. Regulate private agencies.
6. Decentralize the system

Break down the monopoly – create a two-tiered system

7. Promote a deliberately two-tiered system that will alleviate pressure on the public system and allow for healthy competition;
 - a. Copy the most effective private sector models;
 - b. Let people choose how to resolve their health issues.
 - c. Bypass union circles.
 - d. Delegate certain non-essential "care";

8. Delegate more tasks

- a. Recognize foreign credentials more quickly;
- b. Reduce the influence of the College of Physicians, seen as a union, and give more power to nurses, pharmacists, or orderlies. Training could be offered or required to perform certain delegated tasks;
- c. Expand the power of nurses;
- d. Expand the power of pharmacists;

9. Improving Working Conditions

- a. Establish dignity in the workplace for nurses: end the culture of overtime;
- b. In labor disputes between nurses and the state, address the injunction to a higher court than the state court (false defense);
- c. Remove irritants for current staff to encourage entry into the profession and retention.

10. Improving Service Delivery

- a. Regulate “alternative” practices;
- b. Maintain state-recognized skills accreditation;
- c. Allow choice of care type;
- d. Establish a commission to evaluate care methods in other countries to identify best practices worldwide. (Complete overhaul based on best models)
- e. Reduce quotas for health professions training programs (increase the supply of workers);

11. Reviewing Network Funding Methods

- a. Insurance payments must remain reasonable for all workers;
- b. Change the way pharmaceutical companies are subsidized so they become "shareholders";
- c. Require studies independent of pharmaceutical companies (university involvement, third-party certification, federal requirements);
- d. Review the funding for certified "medical" equipment;

Accidents

Since accidents are more likely to occur during the active part of life, it is conceivable that healthcare funding should depend on a percentage of expected working time. Consequently,

1. Payment by insurance should remain;
2. Establish separate accident areas where possible, in order to isolate the causes (pathogens);
3. Coverage included with driver's licenses for road accidents;
4. Mandatory employer-provided insurance to cover workplace accidents under their responsibility, which would increase accountability for workplace safety by "penalizing" poor employers with higher premiums;
5. Enforce workplace safety standards;
6. Coverage of medical expenses related to the performance of duties for military and police personnel;
7. Allow the addition of "clear" coverage for care related to domestic problems;
8. Implement a short-stay trauma surgery program;
9. Eliminate no-fault insurance for impaired drivers or those involved in criminal activity. Make the person responsible for the accident liable for the medical care of road accident victims; insurance should be automatic to avoid administrative burdens for the individual or their family; use the same criminal trial to handle civil claims. Include special provisions for insolvent individuals.

Social Hygiene (Prevention)

Four categories of diseases are directly linked to human activities and depend on choices, or at least on organization. These are: diet, the environment, pathogens, sexuality, and intoxication (drugs, cigarettes).

1. Regulate the sale and production of certain harmful "goods" with standards:
 - a. Strengthen environmental anti-pollution laws;
 - b. Waste management (see our platform);
 - c. Tax foods recognized as harmful to health to cover the costs incurred;
 - d. Regulate and decriminalize prostitution;
 - e. Combat hard drugs and drug addiction.

2. Promote physical exercise and healthy lifestyle habits;

Pediatrics and Gerontology

Children should be considered a separate category, incapable of autonomy, and therefore not subject to co-payments.

The elderly represent a potential accumulation of costs over a lifetime (the lifetime tax). These costs will inevitably rise with the need for expensive care before death.

1. Provide care within the community: Nurses in schools and nurses in long-term care facilities;
2. Fund families who wish to become caregivers;
3. Severely punish cases of violence against seniors and youth;
4. Maintain state-funded pediatric care;
5. Offer humane treatment for palliative and end-of-life care, allowing people to die with dignity;
6. Allow euthanasia, ensuring it is performed with dignity and in accordance with the individual's wishes;
 - a. However, inciting someone to die, as it is currently practiced, must be criminalized.
7. Continue to fund abortions when the child has major genetic problems and for children conceived through rape; define abortion within reasonably humane time limits.
8. Fund vasectomy or tubal ligation for certain genetic diseases and make these procedures available to all adult ages.

Mental Health

1. Strengthen community support groups before referring individuals to hospital.
2. Focus on prevention and invest in civic education.

Preventing the Next Pandemic

1. Implement a pandemic plan to prevent a recurrence of the abusive measures we experienced with COVID-19.

ECONOMY AND PUBLIC FINANCE: BREAK FREE FROM POVERTY AND DEPENDENCY



Politicians in power use public funds to get elected through demagogic promises. We are accumulating debt, becoming increasingly dependent and jeopardizing the future of the next generation, while the current generation benefits. This model of squandering public funds is not only unsustainable in the long term but also inequitable.

The Equipe Autonomiste party considers debt to be pure and simple generational theft. There is no legitimacy that allows a state to incur debt in the name of the community, as this obligates every individual to provide services they have not necessarily received or wanted, services that another generation will have benefited from. The role of the state must be reduced to its minimum, to its essence: ensuring the safety of its citizens, maintaining freedom, and defending private property.

A state does not have income in the strict sense, in the sense that it does not generate voluntary and free exchange. As soon as it exceeds this function, the state becomes tyrannical. The Equipe Autonomiste party favors the principle of a minimal state (libertarianism), believing that citizens will always have more if a civil servant does not act as an intermediary. Financial decision-making then becomes the responsibility of the individual.

A state, like a company, is wealthy according to its savings. Debt is a form of poverty. Its efficiency is relative to its savings (assets) and its revenues relative to its expenditures and debts (liabilities). Debt is the negation of income, just as savings are the negation of expenditure. One must live within one's means. To save, expenses must be minimized and revenues must exceed expenditures.

To achieve this, the Equipe Autonomiste party aims to reduce the size of the state, hold the state accountable once and for all for the management and squandering of public funds, lighten the tax burden on the population, and ultimately, empower the true drivers of prosperity.

Reducing the Size of Government

1. Cut all non-essential government spending, according to a transition plan;
2. Government revenue must be strictly for public goods and not for "social" interests;
3. Simplify taxation (consider automating it);
4. **Production Engineering for the Civil Service: Review the structure of the state**
 - a. Review with unions the requirements for efficiency and flexibility;

Accountability in Public Finance Management

1. Deem national debt (over 50 years) unconstitutional;
2. Amend banking laws to maintain a fund to mitigate economic downturns;
3. Establish a repayment plan for domestic debt and liquidate certain government assets (real estate) freed up by reducing the size of the state;
4. Confiscate the assets of organized crime;
5. Require companies to provide informed product information;
6. Ethically Reform Capitalism
 - a. Limit the borrowing power of governments;
 - b. Prevent government control of certain products, such as maple syrup, to keep prices artificially high;
 - c. Eliminate monopolies;
 - d. Hold business leaders accountable;
7. Combat tax evasion by the government and its employees;
8. Move away from free trade and promote a local and responsible economy;
9. Invest in the Quebec economy for government purchases;
10. Reinststate the Economic Council of Canada to provide the government and the public with a neutral source of information; (Make spending publicly available on an ongoing basis)
11. Protect whistleblowers;
12. Hold corporate executives criminally liable, as they are currently protected by legal fictions such as corporations or shareholder companies.

Reducing the tax burden on the population

1. Reduce the tax burden on individuals (possible by reducing the size of government);
2. Consumer protection;
3. A flat tax rate;
4. Promote philanthropy

Supporting the Drivers of Prosperity

1. Promote local purchasing (and therefore the local economy) by exempting Quebec products from taxes;
2. Encourage innovative businesses;
3. Eliminate unnecessary regulations that stifle entrepreneurship;
4. Encourage major investments in Quebec;
5. Encourage immigration that is ready to invest;
6. Develop local talent and invest in local training.

ENVIRONMENT: SAVED BY GREEN CAPITALISM



The Equipe Autonomiste party denounces the exploitation of eco-anxiety for economic and political ends. However, we truly care about the environment.

We also denounce the idea held by several parties that the environment must be chosen at the expense of the economy; a realistic approach requires a comprehensive vision encompassing both the economy and the environment. **The environment and capitalism can coexist.**

Capitalism can protect the environment by setting fair prices for raw materials and their processing. **The Equipe Autonomiste party therefore considers itself the only party with a realistic strategy for respecting the environment.**

Our environmental plan consists of optimizing resources while respecting nature. To do this, we must work with industry. The true costs of resource exploitation must be included in the calculation; it is in this sense that our approach is realistic and that we can speak of "green capitalism."

By environment, we mean the entire living world we share (water, air, wildlife), in which we live (our habitat). We also understand the environment as a collective property, since no one can produce it; it is necessarily a collective good that must limit free enterprise.

Our task, therefore, is to structure social relations within this environment:

- Inputs (raw material management)
- Outputs (waste management).

Primarily, the principle is divided into three parts: the management of raw resources, processes (industry or consumption), and production, a portion of which is not consumed—this is waste (the unnecessary or useless portion, and consequently, also non-marketable).

Major transformations are primarily driven by industry, and the primary focus should be on environmental responsibility within industry, but also on the waste cycle (waste management) and responsible consumption.

Optimizing Resources

1. REDUCTION AT THE SOURCE

- a. Widespread deposit system.
- b. Resource management (forests, mines, oceans, etc.);
- c. Encourage the local economy by reducing free trade;
- d. Establish and promote a legal framework for the exploitation of raw materials;
- e. Privatization of water beyond a certain consumption level (beyond normal domestic consumption); particularly for water sales to multinationals, increase prices to a fair level;

2. AIMING FOR ZERO WASTE

- a. Combat planned obsolescence;
- b. Mandatory full compensation for industries (for example, for shale gas, costs related to inconveniences to residents due to neighborhood effects) ensuring that the true environmental and social price is paid;
- c. Consider the environment (forests, water, mines) as a collective asset when it is non-renewable for a generation;
- d. Require companies to pass on the costs associated with production, such as soil decontamination and reforestation, so that the true cost is borne by the consumer;
 - i. Ensure, within a legal framework, that companies have the reserve fund to cover environmental compensation;
- e. Withdraw from the Kyoto Protocol and finance our own research with the savings;
- f. Aim to optimize the use of discarded materials, particularly by reintegrating them into production, in order to avoid resource depletion.

WORK: A NEW "SOCIAL CONTRACT" WITH TRADE UNIONS AND PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS



The primary goal of labor law should be to produce consumer goods based on the principle of freedom of employment, provided that reasonable working conditions are in place.

There are limitations regarding workers' health and safety. A prosperous society requires competence and hard work. Unfortunately, a certain union movement tends to compensate for opposing, anti-productive forces.

It's an open secret that unions encourage people to work less, sometimes protect incompetent workers, resist necessary reforms, push for higher wages by creating competition, hinder the smooth functioning of labor, and are politically partisan. For this reason, a segment of the population that desires a strong and healthy economy opposes unions, both publicly and privately.

What matters to the Equipe Autonomiste party is that sound and uniform labor laws be established. However, since the role of work is not to "burn" men and women, but to produce goods, we must recognize that unions have a role to play provided that they also recognize that employers have one as well.

We consider the right of workers to work in honest and decent conditions to be a fundamental principle of human dignity. Consequently, the Equipe Autonomiste party recognizes the need for a form of labor organization based on unions to prevent employer abuses, but also considers unions illegitimate when they become counterproductive monopolies.

The union must be free, accountable, transparent, and representative.

Based on the principle of subsidiarity, the State must intervene between the union (workers) and employers to regulate employment contracts. Conflicts between the State and civil servants should be resolved through democratic bodies. The public must also participate in the development of genuine labor laws.

Ethical Capitalism

1. Implement a pilot project for a standard 35-hour work week. This measure would apply to employees and be adjustable according to the unemployment rate. The goal of this measure is to promote the redistribution of working time rather than the redistribution of honestly earned wages. This measure aims to bring more people into the workforce.
2. Introduce tax-free overtime.
3. Gradually reduce social assistance for able-bodied individuals; motivate people to return to work through in-house training or gradual integration into the labor market.
4. Fairly regulate the free market; allow employers to hire whomever they want, i.e., remove quota obligations from the Diversity, Equity Inclusion rule (so-called "positive discrimination"); let employers determine the wages of their choice;
5. Accelerate Employment Insurance to bring benefits back within reasonable timeframes;

Reforming the way civil servants work

1. Improve work-life balance and work flexibility;
2. Combat the "do as little as possible" culture;
3. Abolish "positive" discrimination and discriminatory quotas.

Reforming Unions

The Equipe Autonomiste party considers it legitimate for employees to unionize to protect themselves against employer abuses, but considers union interference in the political sphere, the promotion of incompetence, and the "least possible" approach illegitimate.

1. Make Unions **FREE**
 - a. Review the Labour Code and the application of the RAND formula; (The ability to choose and pay dues to the union of one's choice);
 - b. Require union members to hold secret ballots for union certification, strike votes, and return-to-work votes;
 - c. The right of self-employed workers to be represented;
2. Make Unions **ACCOUNTABLE**

- a. Fines for the offenses of union members;
 - b. Reform the culture of "least possible," of turf wars, and of defending the incompetent
3. Make Unions TRANSPARENT
- a. Require unions to publish their financial statements;
 - b. Monitor union spending (union transparency);
4. Reinstate the REPRESENTATIVE role of workers
- a. Limit the scope of union actions to refocus them on their original mission: protecting workers from employer abuses, as well as ensuring health and safety in the workplace;
 - b. Limit the unions' right to strike, but transform them into representative bodies to improve labor laws for society as a whole;
 - c. Maintain hierarchical structures within companies to help employers better manage their employees (countering union abuses);
 - d. Make strikes a last resort for negotiation;
 - e. Establish representative channels between unions and the state to improve overall legislation concerning the workplace.

Reforming Professional Orders

1. Reduce the number of trades
2. Revalue manual trades;
3. Eliminate the "cartel" culture in environments where competent people could contribute to professional services.

AGRI-FOOD: FOOD SOVEREIGNTY



Given that food laws and quality standards are not standardized and that unfair competition exists between countries regarding environmental and hygiene requirements, Équipe Autonomiste party proposes that Quebec adopt a **food sovereignty policy**.

The goal is to strengthen our domestic markets and local economies. Food sovereignty is a way to reduce our dependence on imported food, since food is not a commodity like any other. The ideal of food sovereignty is to become as self-sufficient as possible and to prioritize local transportation.

1. Standardize food traceability regarding origin and production standards;
 - a. Meat traceability;
 - i. Including traceability of all genetically modified organisms and types of animal feed;
 - ii. Traceability and monitoring of animal living and slaughter conditions;
 - b. Declaration of pesticide use;
 - c. Transparency of ingredients for human consumption;
 - d. Public declaration and taxation of financial statements related to religious certifications (in the interest of fairness and secularism);
2. Accreditation agreement for imported food to ensure that the same environmental criteria are met;
3. Eliminate supply management for milk, eggs, and poultry;
4. Support cooperatives as a model for producing, processing, and marketing agricultural and fisheries products.
5. Limit the "colonization of land" by restricting the sale of arable land to citizens only; prevent large consortiums from undermining family farming;
6. Implement appropriate tariff barriers on local products, if necessary, to develop our own agricultural sector and avoid asymmetrical competition.
7. Protect the domestic market.
8. Encourage secular certification in the agri-food sector to preserve our culture.

TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE :



Our vision is to maintain individual autonomy in transportation as much as possible and to ensure scheduled road maintenance.

The role of the state should be to assess current and future needs in shared infrastructure, not to impose a particular mode of transport on citizens, arbitrarily chosen by ideologues in suits. However, while current governments are forcing citizens toward unproven technology, the state of our roads is not only neglected, but disastrous.

Considering that electric vehicles generate non-environmental waste during their production and management processes, **the Equipe Autonomiste would abolish the requirement to own an electric car, allowing consumers to choose.**

Roads must be repaired efficiently and regularly, with a budget allocated for this purpose. Regarding greenhouse gases, we will ensure the maintenance of vegetation cover and a responsible population level.

1. Maintain the choice between gasoline-powered and electric vehicles; we believe that banning gasoline-powered vehicles is too drastic a measure;
2. Maintain the condition of infrastructure available to all at a fair price;
 - a. Scheduled road maintenance;
 - b. 30-year plan for the rehabilitation of road infrastructure;
 - c. Standardize wildlife protection in civil engineering;
3. Establish or maintain highway bus services;
4. Revitalize bulk transportation, such as rail, to alleviate road congestion;
5. Improve public transportation;
